 - (ii) General Mental ability:- Number Series, classifications, analogies, Synonyms and Antonyms, Code & De-code.
 - (iii) Language proficiency in Hindi and English: Grammar, Idioms and Vocabulary, correction and punctuation, fill in the blanks, Comprehension.
- Part B will have 50 questions based on the following Teaching Aptitude.
 - Knowledge of teaching, learning process of educational system including nonformal and distance education.
 - (ii) Audio-visual aids & mass media etc.
 - (iii) Value as enshrined in the Constitution of India.
 - (iv) General awareness of national level educational agencies.
