Most of the B.Tech. Programmes of the University are accredited from NBA.

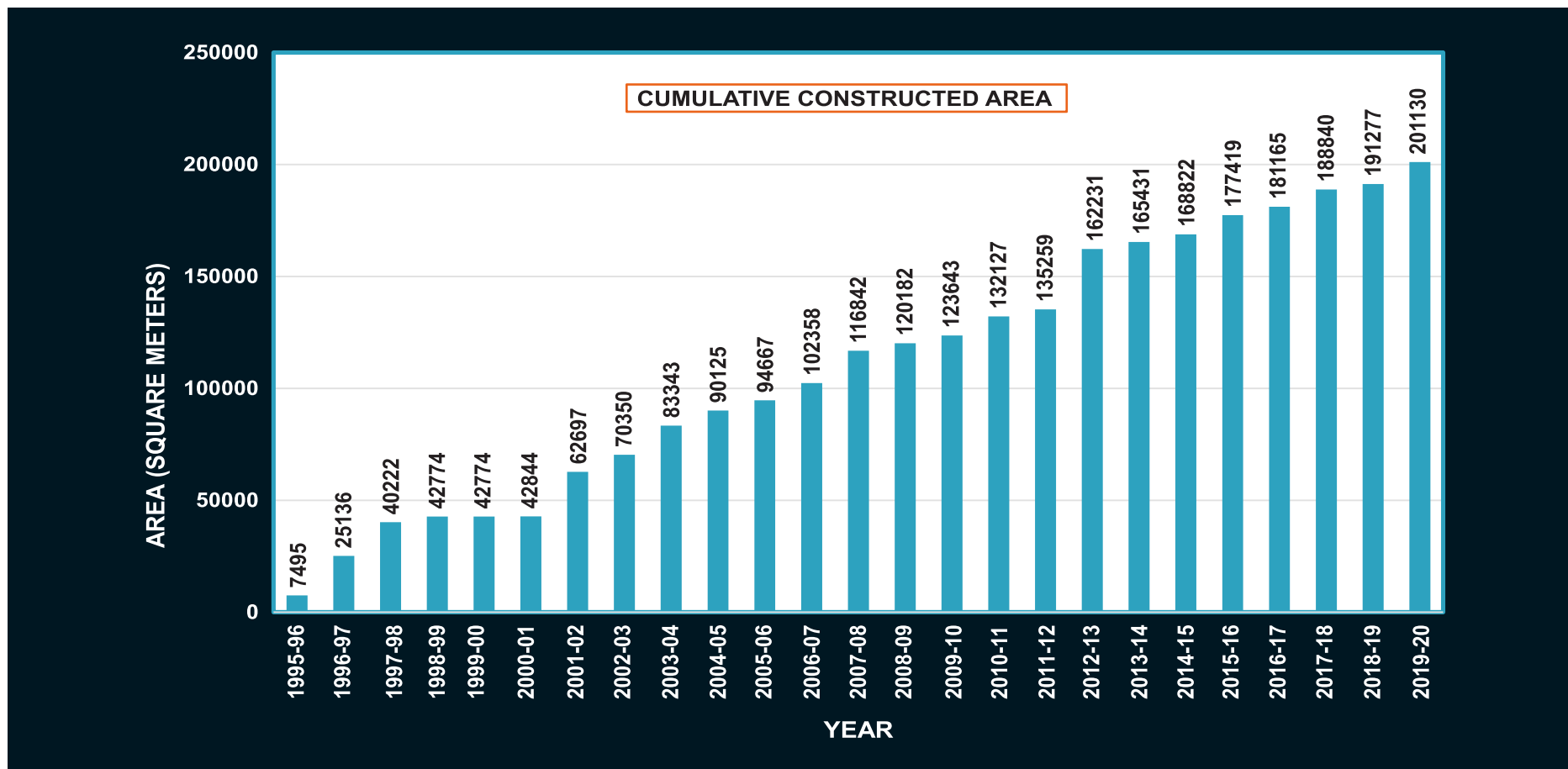

### **Journey of Infrastructural Development in the University**

The University started working in Guru Jambheshwar Bhawan in 1996-97. In the starting phase C-type houses, A – type houses, Teaching Block No. 1, Sub-Station No. 1 and Boys Hostel No. 1 was constructed followed by Guru

Jambheshwar Bhawan, Vice Chancellor Residence, VIP Guest House, Sub-ordinate guest house, Girls Hostel No.1, Teaching Block-2, Residential quarters both A and C types, Administrative Block for Vice Chancellor and Registrar, Shopping Complex and D type houses.

In the present day context, the University is situated over a sprawling area of about 372 acres. The campus is laid out with picturesque landscape, numerous buildings of various designs and wide road network. It presents a spectacle of harmony in architecture and natural beauty. Approximately, 275 acres of land have been developed providing with all facilities. The journey of infrastructural amenities creation is still on and the University is well equipped with the various infrastructural facilities in the campus including: eight spacious Teaching Blocks, Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Incubation and Innovation Centre (under construction), Bio & Nano Technology Centre, Haryana School of Business, Central Instrumentation lab, Radio Technogy Centre, Four Boys Hostels, Four Girls Hostels, One Working Women Hostel, University Central Library, Research

Laboratories in each Department, Pt. 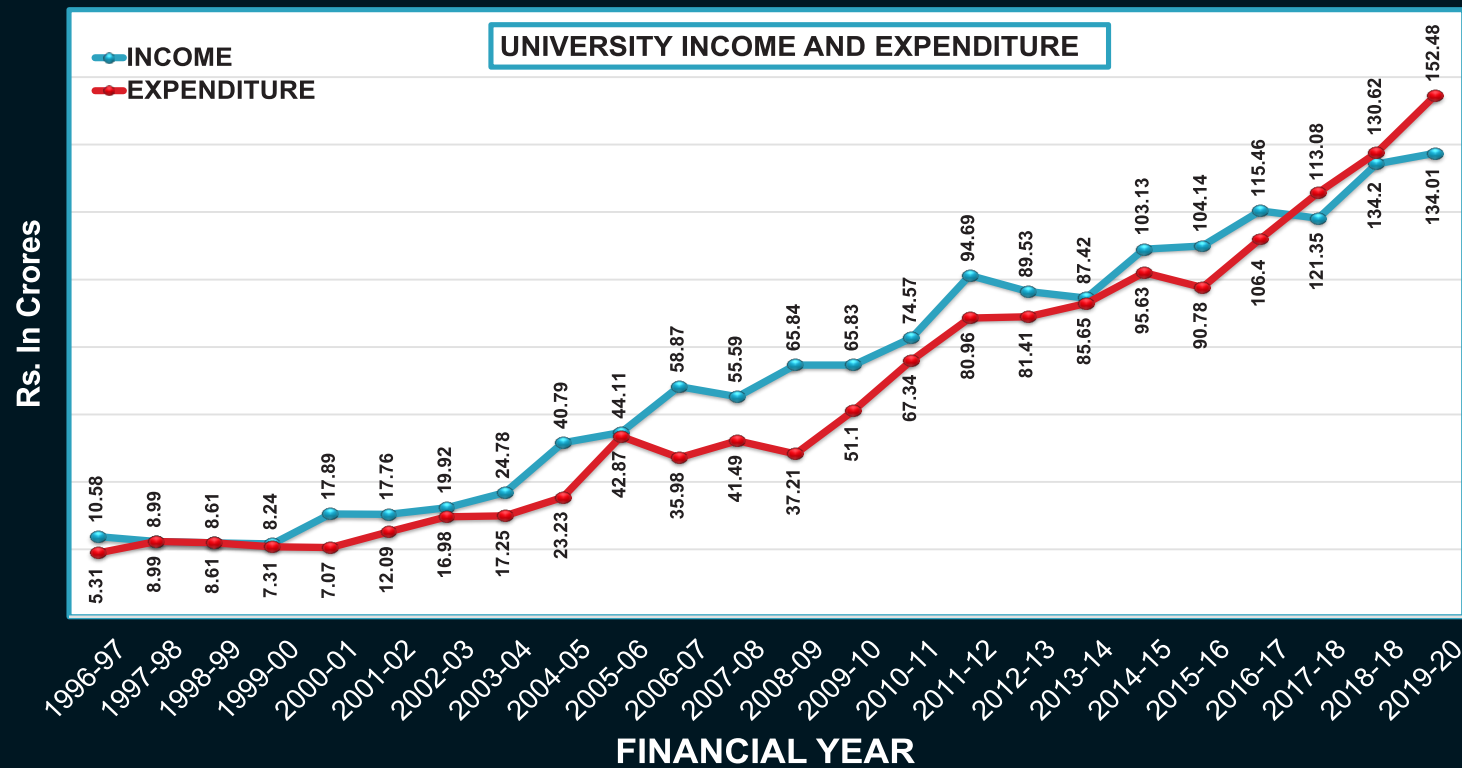
The University started its journey with only 09 UG and PG programmes now the number of courses offered by this prestigious institute are 55.

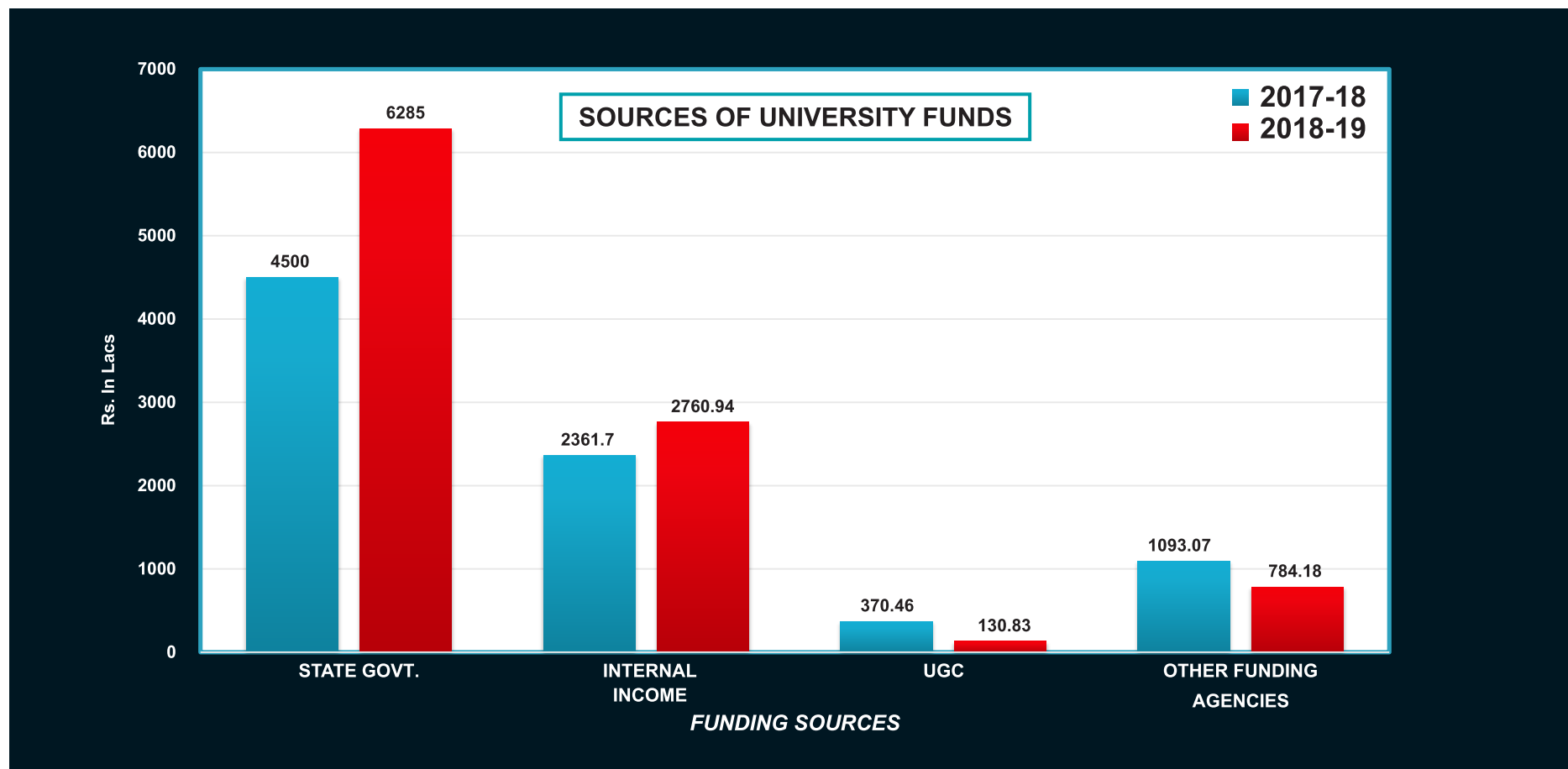

Well Structured Network of Teacher & Student Placement Coordinators in all departments.

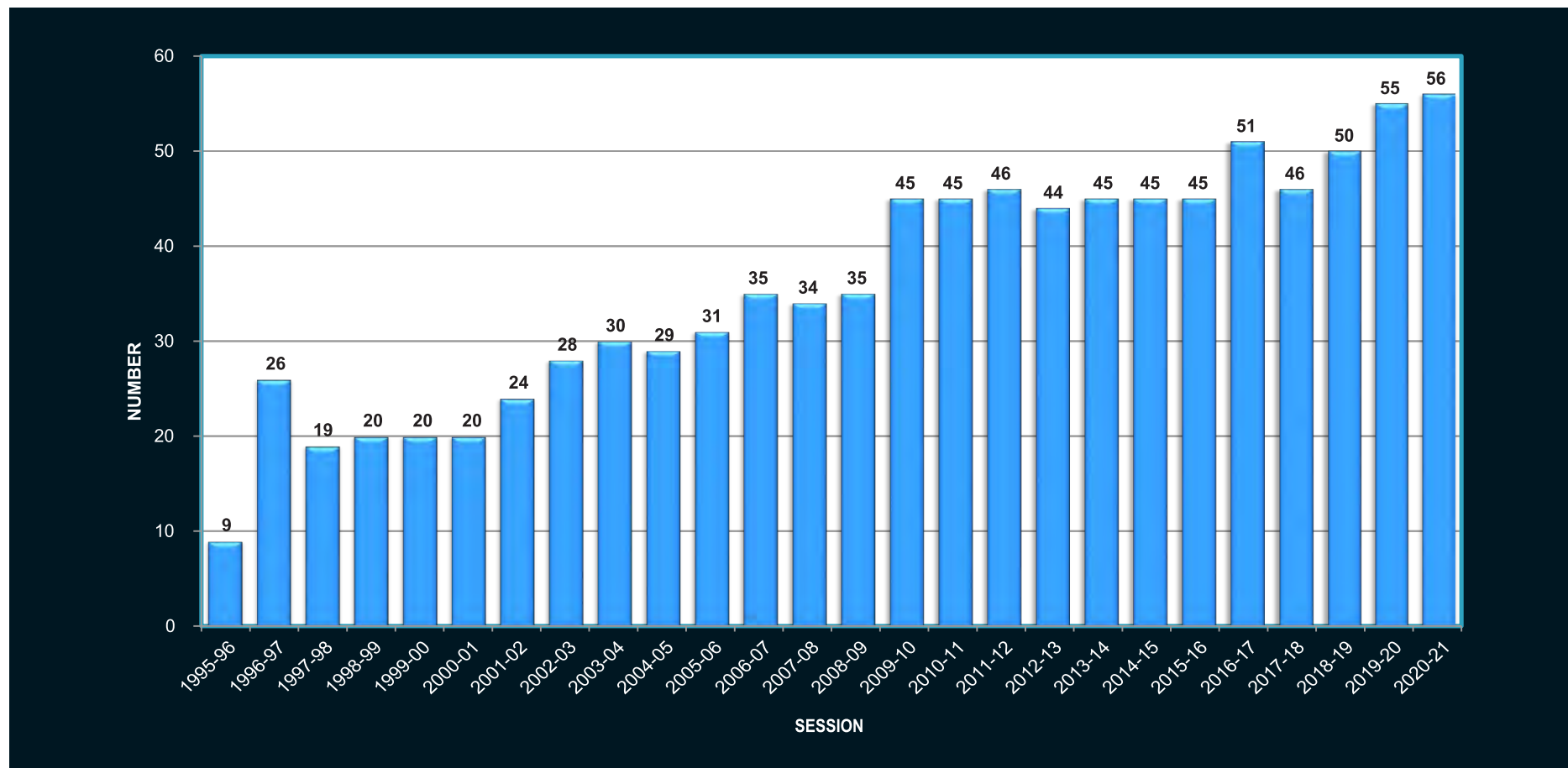

### DR. BHIM RAO AMBEDKAR LIBRARY

The University Library has a circular designed three storey building with a







seating capacity of 400 seats. The Library has a collection of 116022 books and 5850 bound volumes of Journals. The Library has received 284 Indian Journals, 41 Magazines and 20 Newspapers. The Library, in its electronic repository has the access to 7500+ e-journals of 19 publishers through UGC-INFONET Consortium under e-Shodhsindhu Project. The University library has more than 7 Lacs E-books through NDL and the University has purchased 180000+ e-books for the University students.

Besides this, the Library has the perpetual access of SPSS and also subscribed ProWess, POP of IEEE. In addition, NPTEL (National Programme

on Technology Enhanced Learning) Video Lectures are available on the Campus Wide Network. A DD Free Dish under SWAYAM PRABHA Programme initiated by Government of India having 32 Educational Channels has been installed in the Video Conferencing Hall of the library. Further to cope up with the current information demands of the science users, the library has taken the life time Institutional membership of Current Science Association. To access the existing databases and e-resources, the Library has established two labs i.e. Research Database Lab for the Research Scholars & Faculty Members and SC/ST students Lab with state-of-the-art facility. Besides, the



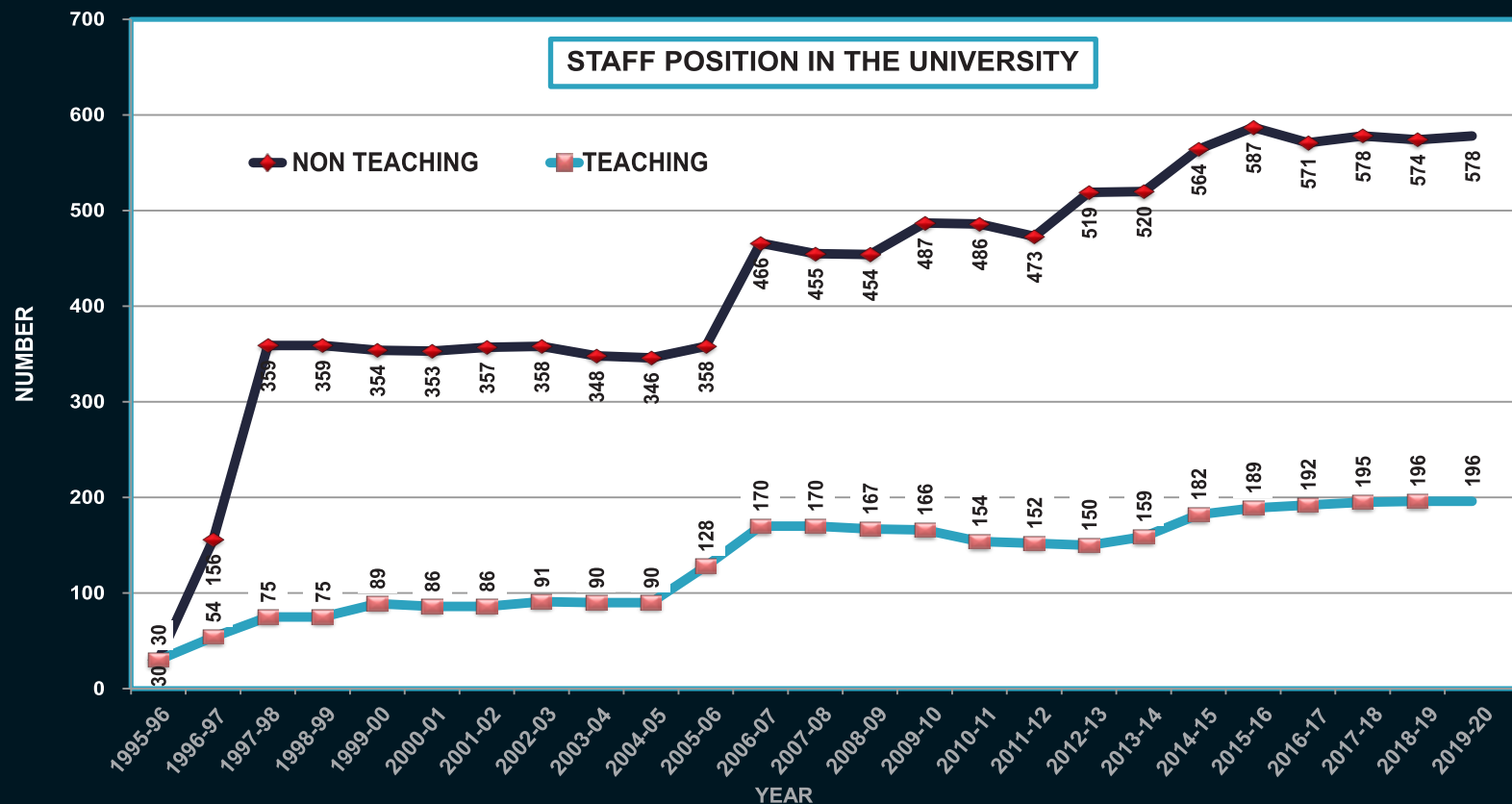
OPENING CEREMONY OF DAE-SOLID STATE PHYSICS SYMPOSIUM (2018)

University Library provides the facility to detect & check plagiarism with Turnitin: An Anti-Plagiarism Software. Moreover, to provide the access of university these in public domain, the Library has signed the MoU with INFLIBNET (Information Library Network Centre), Gandhinagar for Shodhganga Repository and accordingly the soft copies of these are being sent to INFLIBNET as and when receive in the Library for uploading into Shodhganga Repository. Apart from the above, the Library has the membership of National Digital Library of India, which is the biggest repository of its kind of e-resources for the students.

### A GLANCE AT THE RESEARCH ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY

A total of 2761 research papers have been published by the faculty in SCOPUS with over 44781 citations. One research paper has been cited more than 1600 times, 04 papers have been cited more than 500 times and 73 papers cited more than 100 times and average paper citations 16.21. At present the h-Index of the University has also gone up to 87 from 17 in 2009-10, it shows the quality of research in GJUST.

Eight departments of the university have been awarded SAP-DRS projects by UGC while four departments have been awarded FIST grant from DST, Nano Mission Grant from DST, HRD and BIF grant DBT Govt. of India.



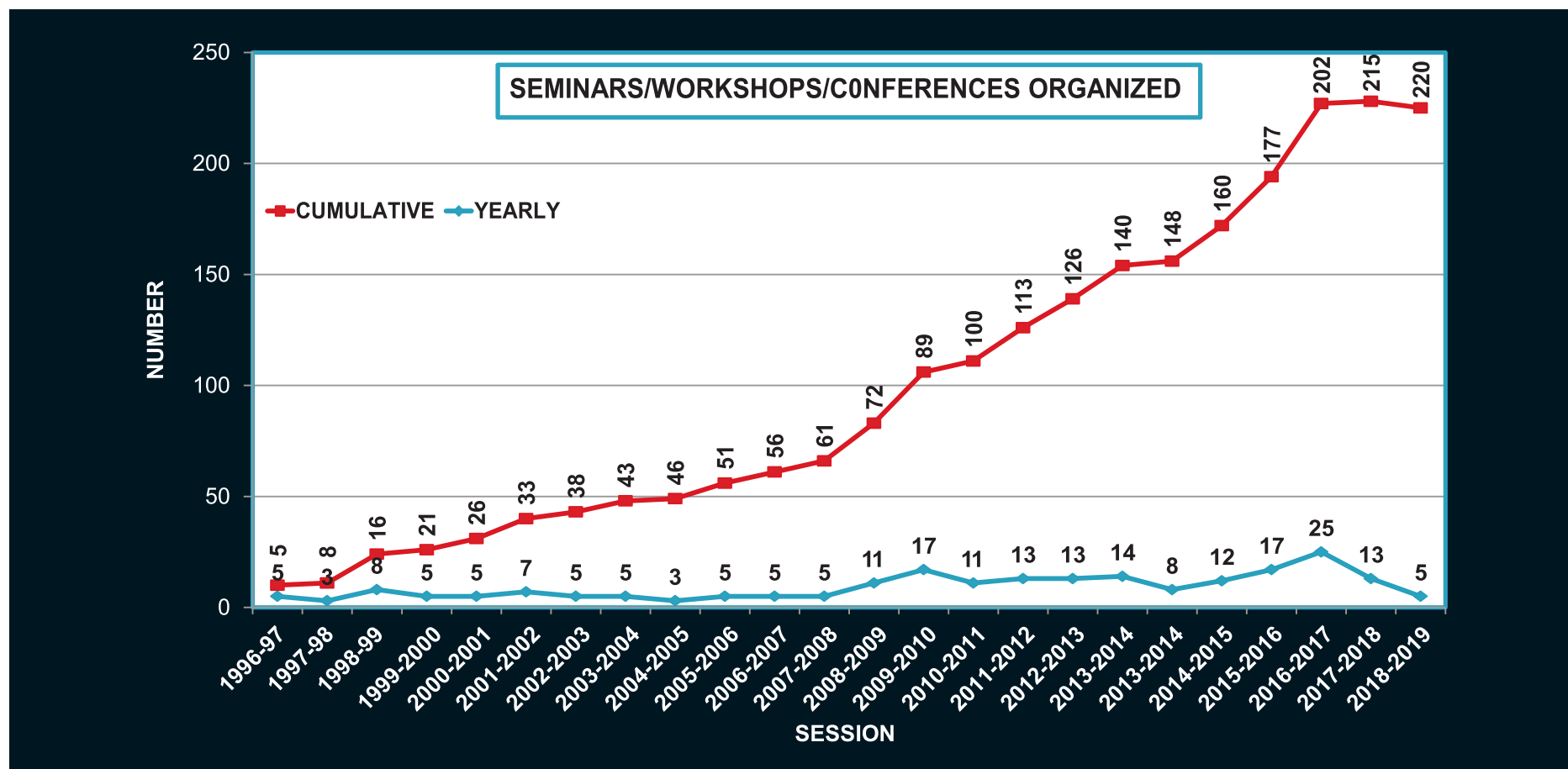
**COMMENCEMENT OF SILVER JUBILEE YEAR**

The UGC has released the assistance of General Development Grant of Rs.6.79 crore during the 12th plan period.



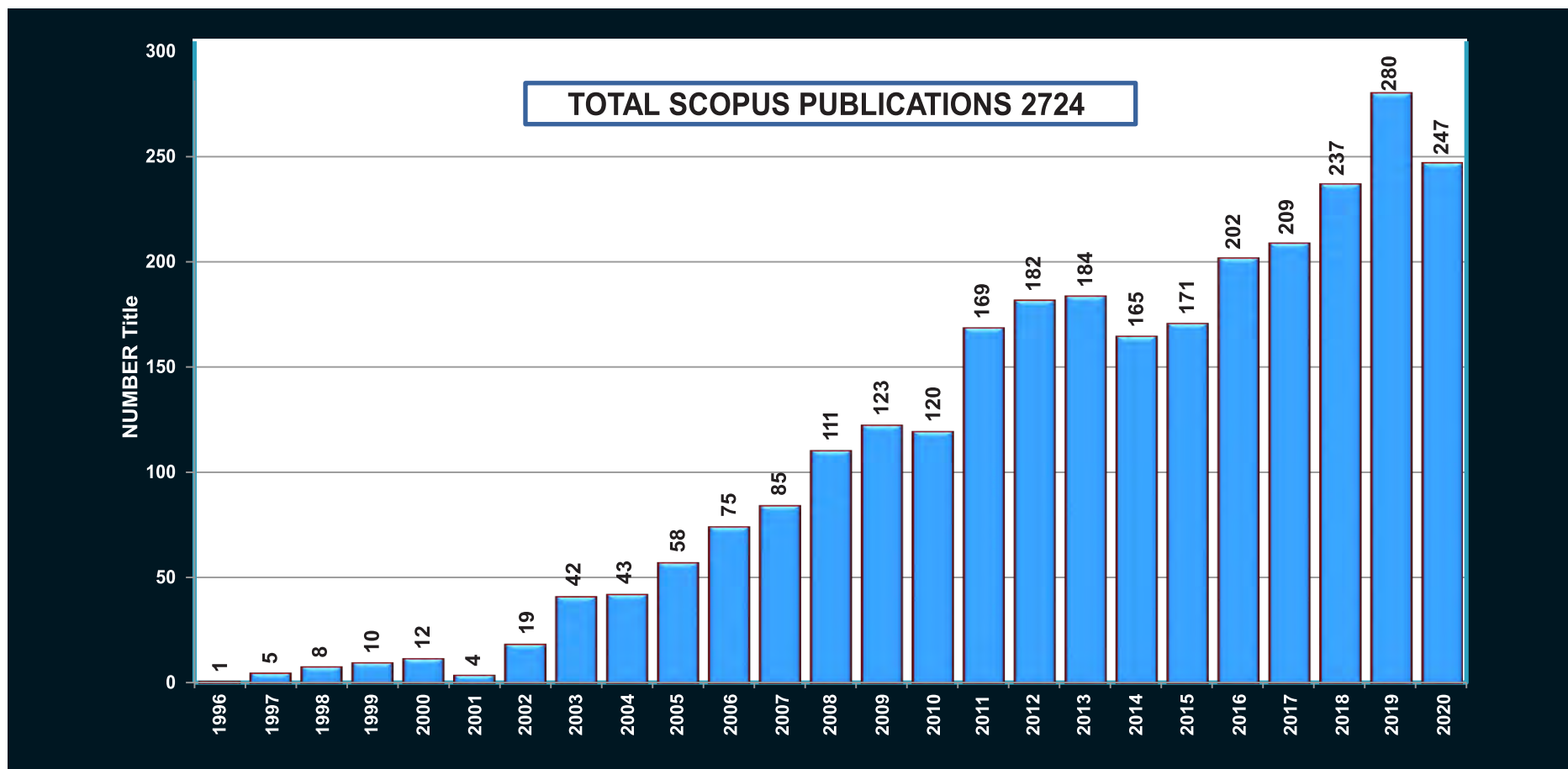
